

SECOND PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2017
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
SEPTEMBER 11, 2017 AT 4:45 PM
LEWISTOWN MUNICIPAL BUILDING COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The meeting opened at 4:45 PM with Borough Council President Mr. Berrier presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

ROLL CALL

Mr. Wilson, Mr. Rager, and Mr. Berrier were present. Mr. Moore, Mr. Felmlee, Larry Searer and Mr. Eddinger were absent.

Mr. Moore came in at 4:50 PM.

HEARING OF PERSONS PRESENT

Mr. (Jim) Lettiere, from the County Planning Office, stated this is the second of two required public hearings held for Lewistown Borough's 2017 CDBG application. The first public hearing was held on August 14, 2017 with several proposals for consideration. The total allocation is \$116,929 with 15% for planning and administration which amounts to \$17,539.35. The balance is to be funded for two road projects, Spring Street Road Reconstruction and a segment of Grand Parkway North. The Spring Street project is from State Route 522 North to the Borough line with a total project cost of \$85,170. For the Grand Parkway North Segment, it is from the entrance into the middle school up to Winding Way with a project cost of \$23,795. However, the balance left to fund this project is \$14,219.65, so the rest of the funds will come from the 2018 allocation. It will be considered a multi-year funded project. The application is due to PA DCED by November 3, 2017.
