PennDOT Mifflin County Maintenance Work Schedule for the Week of September 16

Clearfield, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced the following schedule of maintenance activities in Mifflin County the week of September 16. PennDOT performs year-round maintenance in its mission to provide a safe, efficient transportation system, and the scope of work in Mifflin County for the coming week is as follows:

Base Repair:

• Route 4006 (Back Mountain Road) between the intersections of Route 305 in Union Township and Route 1005 (Old US 322) in Armagh Township. Monday, September 16, through Thursday, September 19. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.

Base repair is intended to repair fatigue cracked, potholed or distorted pavement sections and restore the structural integrity of the pavement. All distressed material within the area, including the material beneath the asphalt, is removed and replaced with sound material. The new material is then compacted before being overlayed with new asphalt. Base repair extends the service life of good and fair roads and provides a smooth, safe ride for motorists.

Bridge Maintenance & Cleaning

 Route 3017 (Ferguson Valley Road) at a bridge spanning Beaver Dam Run approximately two miles north of Newton Hamilton in Wayne Township. Monday, September 16, through Thursday, September 19. PennDOT will implement a detour using Little Greenbriar Road, Greenbriar Crossover Road, and Big Greenbriar Road.

Pennsylvania has some of the oldest bridges in the country, with an age of more than 50 years on average. Preventive maintenance is vital in extending the life of the structures. As such, PennDOT maintenance crews perform some bridge deck patching and structural repairs.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies, or other unforeseen interruptions.
